Plastics Operations

- Safe start up, shutdown and continuous operation of extruders and associated equipment.
- Continuous monitoring of plant ensuring that finished product meets specifications and that production targets are met.
- Problem solve and carry out first aid maintenance where necessary.
- Carry out in-line QC checks to ensure finished goods are in specification according to customer requirements.
- Rewind master rolls on automatic and semi-automatic winders as required.
- Formalise production reporting, including completion of shift logs including rates of production and downtime (both hard copy and IT based systems).
- Pack and label finished goods as per customer requirements.
- Goods receipt of raw materials in line with company Standard Operating Procedure (SOP).
- Display behaviours consistent with the stated Winson Values.
- Participate in team huddles and contribute to continuous improvement projects in the work area.

Workplace Health & Safety

- Complete daily forklift checks at the commencement of specified shift as per appropriate check list.
- Ensure integrity of safety switches and guarding on all machinery.
- Personal Protective Equipment to be worn as directed at all times and safe working practices, (such as correct lifting technique) are adopted and used.
